

DO YOU HAVE THE RIGHT PRODUCT HOLDER?



Grote Slicer Guide

Having the right product holder for your slicer and food application is critical for quality slicing and avoiding machine wear. Use this guide to determine you have the right product holder and to define a new product holder request.

How to know you may have the wrong product holder

- You bought a *used slicer* or *changed the application or food product*
- You are experiencing *slice quality issues*, including inconsistent or wedge slices and excess waste
- The slicer has *premature wear*, specifically to the blade guide and motor – **increasing downtime** and **maintenance costs**
- *Your product does not fit correctly* into the product holder

Correct product holder fit

Product holders are custom-made based on the machine model, production rate and application, and product specifications.

To generally determine product holder fit accuracy, measure the clearance around the diameter of your product. If the clearance is more/less than .063 inches (1.59 mm), you may need a new product holder.

How to get a new product holder custom-made
